The City of Des Moines invites you to attend an open house to discuss a construction project planned for the Lower Oak Park neighborhood. See the attached map for the location of the Phase 2 and 3 storm sewer improvements.

The Lower Oak Park and Highland Park Sewer Separation Project is part of the City's Long Term Control Plan, developed to eliminate combined sewer overflows. The Plan requires the City to comply with federal water quality standards and reduce the number of raw sewage overflows to our rivers and streams. The primary goal of the Project is to eliminate the combined sewer overflows at the Birdland Marina. This Project will help Des Moines and your neighborhood contribute to improving the Des Moines River's water quality.

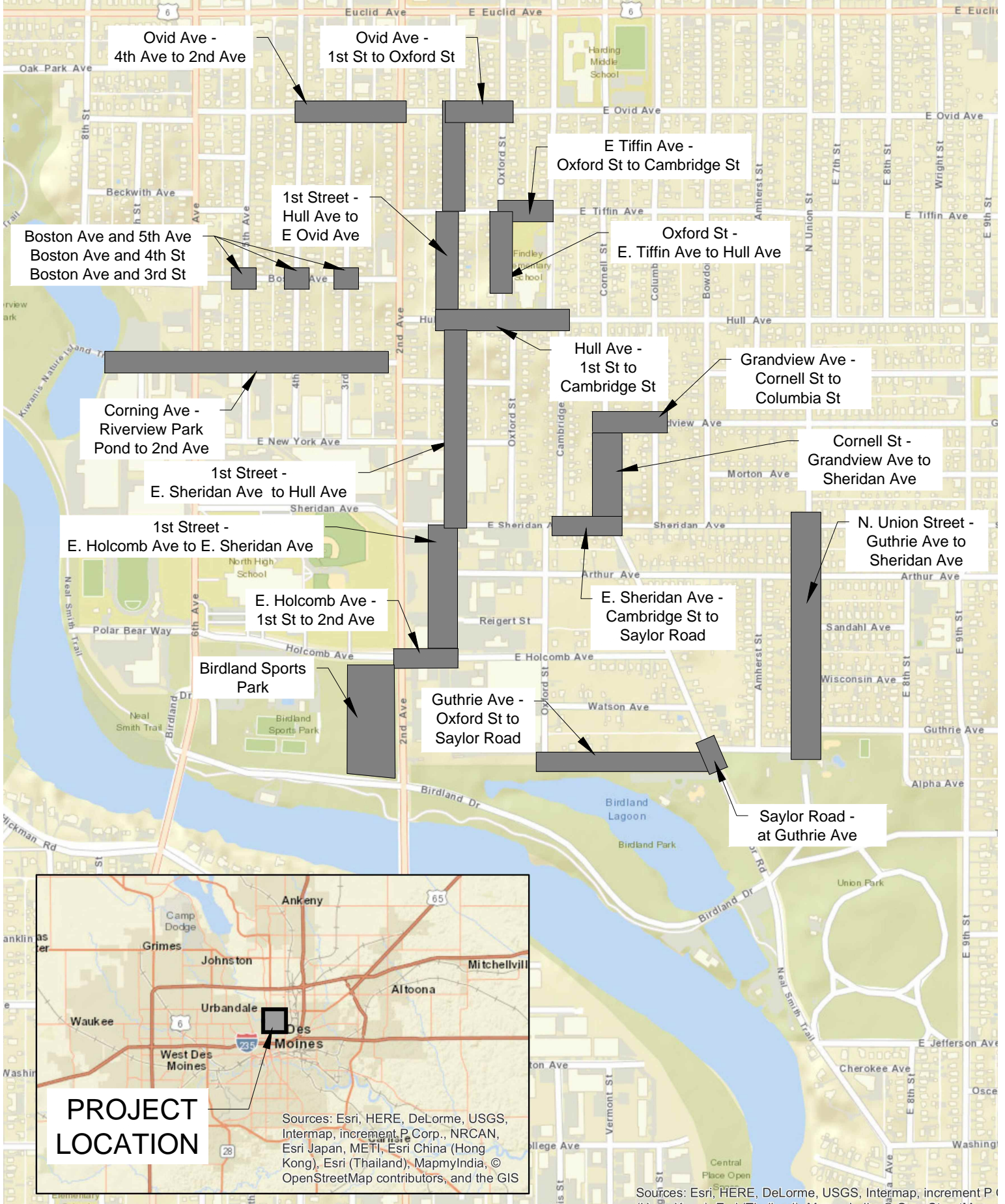
The Project Team has prepared preliminary construction drawings for Phase 2 and 3 of the project. Join us to learn more about the planned work to be completed in the neighborhood:
